### **Camp Activities**

#### **ASL (American Sign Language) Station**

Fingerspelling and basic conversational ASL will be taught through fun and engaging activities such as storytelling. Native ASL speaker Deaf camp counselors will also be invited on select days. Children will also be introduced to Deaf culture and De'VIA (Deaf visual arts).





#### **Chef's Corner**

Students will work together for a different project each time. Planned activities include introduction to cuisines from around the world and making: jams, popcorn, cotton candy, Turkish Delight, ice-cream, and butter (while exercising!). Also available are special projects like ancient art of bread making, introduction to cake world, and cookie & cake decoration.







#### **Inventor's Station (Maker Lab)**









This is a maker lab with full of opportunities for children to foster creativity and independence. Materials available to children include but not limited to electrical circuits, resistors, batteries, light bulbs, selected art/craft supplies, glue gun, variety of wires and other electronics pieces, magnets, and tutorials/books on different projects. Students will be free to choose whatever they want to make. In addition, the following guided activities will be available: Making a telescope, a spectrometer, a conductometer, recycled paper, and a skateboard.

#### **Fashion Designer Studio**



This studio is designed to introduce children how to make clothing and accessories. The studio will include sewing materials, variety of fabric, apparel decorative pieces, sewing machine and liquid stitch. Planned activities: Making hand bags and backpacks, skirts, t-shirts, hats & scarves, wall hanging and magnetic decorative pieces.

#### **Artist and Crafter's Studio**


This studio is perfect for tomorrow's artists. Planned activities include professional jewelry making, making wall hanging and magnetic decorative pieces, variety of painting projects, pottery making, decoration and painting of wooden toys and other craft pieces, lacing, rock painting, playdough/clay crafts, crochet, knitting and needlepoint.

#### Scientist's Lab



In this one-of-a-kind scientist lab, the experiments are designed/chosen to make science relevant, fun and engaging. The following experiments are offered this year: Making soap, rocket science, making candles, carbon snake, making hand and body lotion, potato battery and other types of batteries, chemiluminescence, crime scene investigation, friction study and car racing, and skateboard physics.

#### **Robotics & Coding Station**



This station is designed for children in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and up although younger ones might also be able to participate depending on their interest and skill levels. We have a project-based and fun curriculum fostering creativity and problem-solving skills. Projects involve engineering, programming, math, and physics in a hands-on, collaborative way designed for small teams.

### **Altogether Camp Activities**

## Campers come together for unforgettable time together designed to make this summer the best ever!

#### **Showcase**

Campers come together twice a day after they finish their work in morning and afternoon stations to showcase their work to fellow campers. This is a great opportunity for children to practice expressing themselves and their work. Children from all stations will be invited (but not required) to share their work. While some children showing amazing soaps that they made in Scientist's Lab, other children might sing a song that they learn in Musician's Corner or another child from Writer's Corner may share a story --- opportunities are endless!

#### **Giveback Project**

Campers will be given an opportunity to participate a social responsibility project to be completed together every other week. Campers will produce extra goodies in different stations such as soaps, decorative pieces, popcorn, cotton candy, etc. Then, we will provide a platform to showcase and sell to support children in need in US and around the world.

#### **Scavenger Hunt and Other Camp Games**

Campers will come together once a day to play traditional camp games. Also offered is a huge Scavenger Hunt designed for older and younger ones promising an unforgettable time while fostering problem solving and focusing skills as well as teamwork.

#### **Dates**

#### Fee

Standard camp fee is \$250 per week. We offer variety of discounts and camper scholarships for a limited number of children. Please contact us for more information. \$100/week is required upfront to save your child's space. No registration fee!

#### **Morning drop-off**

Children will be dropped off to our location inside the building after 9:00 am.

#### Afternoon drop-off

Children will be picked up from our location no later than 4 pm. Extended camp care is available upon request until 5 pm with an additional charge of \$20/week.

#### **Lunch & Snacks**

Lunch is not provided unless requested by parents. There is an additional charge of \$7/lunch upon request. The request should be made for all days at the beginning of the camp. Health snacks are provided with no additional charge.
